- Under Data Protection legislation the church Charity Trustees of The Baptist Church, St Peters are the Data Controller and can be contacted by emailing information.stpeters@gmail.com.
- If you complete this 'Contact Us' form on the website we will only retain your name and details for as long as is necessary for us to deal with your enquiry. We will NOT pass on your details to anyone other than the person (or people) in our church who are best able to deal with your enquiry.
- If you have ticked the consent box then we will retain this information to enable the church to keep in touch with you.
- Data Protection legislation allows us to process this information as we regard it as being in the church's legitimate interest.
- Your name and contact details will be entered into our church database which is held on the church admin computer which is password protected and accessed only by the Ministers, Deacons and Church Administrator. Your contact details NOT be disclosed to anyone else without your consent and will be removed from the database should you request it.
- You have the right to ask to see any information we hold about you (including the pastoral support information) by submitting a 'Subject Access Request' to the Church Administrator. You also have the right to ask for information which you believe to be incorrect to be rectified.
- If you are concerned about the way your information is being handled please speak to our Church Administrator. If you are still unhappy you have the right to complain to the Information Commissioners Office
